

CARNIVOROUS PLANTS

- All Sarracenia spp. are 5 yr old blooming plants which need winter dormancy. These are greenhouse started with actively growing traps. Growing tips included with purchase.
- <u>Pitcher Plant, Northern Purple</u> Sarracenia purpurea purpurea Native MN pitcher. Deep reddish-purple very stout waxy pitchers, holds color through winter. Dark red fragrant flowers. 4-8" z2-8 3.5" pot \$25
- NEW! Pitcher Plant, Maroon Sarracenia x maroon (s. purpurea x rubra [s. x chelsonii]) Dark maroon traps all season including winter. Fragrant dark red flowers bloom early spring. 6-8" z5-9 3.5" pot \$25
 - <u>Pitcher Plant, White Trumpet</u> Sarracenia leucophylla White areoles (windows) dominate the upper portions of the tubes attracting many flying insects. Produces few nice traps in the spring, and a burst of large vigorous traps in the fall when other pitcher plants dwindle. 8-28" z5-9 3" pot \$25
- NEW! Pitcher Plant, Formosa Sarracenia x formosa (S. minor x psittacina) Low rosette of dense pinky red tubes develop deepest color in full sun. Scarlet red blooms before traps emerge but last throughout the season. 4-6" z4-8 3.5" pot \$25

- Angelica, Korean Angelica gigas Striking plant for moist woodland or bog. Blooms burgundy in fall through hard freeze. Most asked-about plant at the State Fair pond. 3-5' z4-9 4" pot \$4 6" pot \$7

 Blazing Star, Floristan Violet Liatris spicata 'Floristan Violet' Fluffy wands of bright violet-purple flowers bloom from top to bottom over 4 weeks or more. Finely textured grass-like dark green foliage along the strong stem provides nice contrast and summer interest, turning a rich bronze in the fall. Tolerates poor soils, but doesn't like heavy clay. Slightly more compact than the native. 3-4' z3-9 4" pot \$4
 - Bloody Dock Rumex sanguineus An edible herb (sorrel) with gorgeous dark red veins on deep green upright foliage that likes wet feet. 12-15" z4-8 2" pot \$5
 - <u>Brooklime, European</u> Veronica beccabunga Spectacular creeper over the sides of containers, in streams, along the pond edge. Forms a mat of vegetation near pond edge that attracts frogs and other wildlife. Glossy green foliage stays all summer long with tons of periwinkle-blue flowers in the spring. 4-8" z4-8 2" pot \$5 1 Qt pot \$15
 - e Butterbur Petasites hybridus Huge leaves. Likes moist woodlands or bogs. Deer and rabbit resistant. 3-4' z4-7 1 gal pot \$7
- NEW! Cardinal Flower, White Lobelia cardinals alba Bright white flower spikes from early to mid-summer rise above medium green foliage. Excellent in the natural shade garden or containers. Excellent for cutting, attracts pollinators, serrated leaves remain green throughout the growing season. Keep partially shaded during the heat of summer. 24-36" z3-9 4" pot \$4
 - Cattail, Miniature Typha minima The true "miniature". Perfectly dainty in a container. Catkins about 1" round. 12-15" z4-9 4" pot \$7 1 Qt pot \$15
 - °9 Chameleon Plant Houttuynia cordata Tricolor variegated heart-shaped leaves on vining plant with underground rhizomes. 8-12" z3-9 4" pot \$7
 - Golden Club Orontium aquaticum A true aquatic with pointed oval leaves repel water like a lotus. Long golden spadex add unique interest in late spring. 12-24" z5 2" pot \$5

 Mibiscus, Disco Belle Mix Hibiscus moscheutos A flourish of huge 8" flowers in a mix of pink, white and red with red centers makes this a summer knockout. Plant is bushy and smaller than most hibiscus at 3' or less. Plants are very slow to break dormancy, so don't give up until after July. 30-36" z4-10 4" pot \$4
 - es Iris, Ann Chowning Iris, Louisiana 'Ann Chowning' Mary Swords DeBaillon Medal winner. Vermillion red 6" flowers with lemon-yellow signals blooms late spring. 24-36" z4-9 2" pot \$5
 - oo Iris, Black Gamecock Iris, Louisiana 'Black Gamecock' Unmatched vigor of velvety purple-black large 6" blooms. 24-36" z4-9 4" pot \$7
- NEW! OBJECT ITIS, Black Siberian Iris chrysographes As black as a flower can get, this deep indigo/violet Siberian iris relative will wow in the garden. The tiniest flash of gold in the throat looks like a midnight star. 18-20" z3-8 2" pot \$5
 - Iris, Dixie Deb Iris, Louisiana 'Dixie Deb' Mary Swords DeBaillon Medal winner. Vibrant sulfur-yellow flowers in early to mid-spring. Three larger falls have darker yellow veining to attract pollinators. 24-36" z4-9 2" pot \$5
- NEW! Iris, Japanese Varigated Iris ensata 'Variegata' RHS Award of Garden Merit. Early midseason bloom of bluish-purple. Stunning silvery verticle variegation stays strong all summer. 24-36" z4-9 2" pot \$5
 - o Iris, Red Velvet Elvis Iris, Louisiana 'Red Velvet Elvis' 2005 Mary Swords DeBaillon Medal winner. Dark velvety red-black ruffled blooms with small orange spear. 24-36" z4-9 2" pot \$5
 - Iris, Water Blue Iris Laevigata Blue True water-iris. Deep blue-purple bloom with bold white streak. 24-36" z3-8 2" pot \$5
 - lris, Wow Factor Iris, Louisiana x 'Wow Factor' An interesting cross of Louisiana with Australian variety producing much larger lemon yellow and chocolate blended petals with cinnamon veins. Foliage also slightly larger than standard Louisiana species. 40-48" z5-9 2" pot \$5
 - Lizard's Tail Saururus cernuus 6" large heart shaped green leaves alternate along a slender stem. Long weeping panicles of white flowers at the tips of the stems look like lizard's tail. 18-36" z3-9 2" pot \$5
- NEW! obe Marsh Marigold, Double Caltha palustris 'Plena' Rare double flowering variation of our beloved Minnesota native marsh marigold 6-12" z2-9 1 Qt pot \$15
- NEW! oo Marsh Marigold, Giant Caltha polupetala Native to northern Europe and upper west coast of North America. Buttercup yellow flowers and plant noticably larger than the Minnesota native marsh marigold 12-24" z4-7 1 Qt pot \$15
 - Rush, Pickerel Pink Pontederia cordata 'Pink pons' Tall glossy elongated leaves are a late starter, but put on a beautiful all-summer show. Pannicle of rosy pink flowers mid to late summer. 24-36" z3-10 1 Qt pot \$15
 - Sedge, Bowles Golden Carex elata 'Bowles Golden' Bright gold tufted foliage with thin green margins. Moisture loving grass that needs to be constantly wet or moist to thrive. 24-30" z4-8 2" pot \$7
 - Sweet Flag, Varigated Acorus calamus variegata Iris-like foliage with unusual vertical variegation. Maintenance-free. 24-36" z3-10 Bare Root \$3-\$10
- NEW! Thalia, Powdery Thalia dealbata Dramatic clump of long paddle-shaped blue-green foliage atop strong upright stems. Plant is covered in subtle white powder. Packed panicles of purple flowers sits at the end of a long arching stem. Pollinator attractive. 3-6' z6-11 2" pot \$5
 - Water Baby's Breath, European Alisma plantago aquatica Hosta-looking plant for the water that provides a flourish of blush to white tiny flowers like a cloud on a tall spike. 24-36" z3-9 4" pot \$6
 - Water Celery Oenanthe Great filtering bog plant with celery-like foliage and flowers. 8-15" z3-10 6" pot \$5

Yerba Mansa Anemopsis californica Herb native from Oregon to Southern California, a lovely plant with sturdy thick oblong green leaves which turn beautiful shades of gold, orange and red in the fall. The flower is a spray of bright white petals surrounding a long cone-like stigma. Propagates through runners, needs some winter protection. 12-24" z5-10 2" Pot \$5 1 Qt pot \$15

- All lotus are bare root tubers. Prices range from \$5-\$50 depending upon variety and size of tuber. Multiple price points are available in each variety.

 Ai Jiangnan_Nelumbo nucifera Plate-like huge cheery yellow flowers with green tips on first day, adding some creamy pink on subsequent days.

 Flowers held above the very low and wide deep blue-green leaves. M z3-10
- NEW!

 Beijing Temple of Heaven Nelumbo nucifera Super-saturated pink flower color with an emerald green receptacle and a large collar of heavy white anthers. Recentacle and stamen go through vibrant color changes with something new every day. Leaves stand very tall 1, 23-10.
- Dancing in Jade Tower Nelumbo nucifera Best MN bloomer in 2021. Grows to size of container, perfect for small pots on patio. Single and semi-double on same plant changes pink to white with pink edges. S z3-10
- NEW! Ounhuang Red (Dunhuang Hong) Nelumbo nucifera Luscious pink flowers bigger than a dinner plate and broad petals. Flower ages to a soft pink that almost glows. Plant in large tub only to support weight of flowers. Great bloomer once it gets going. L z3-10
- NEW! Fire Red Nelumbo nucifera This sassy little red lotus will brighten up your day! Fire Red is a single-petal bowl lotus with really vibrant color. It grows about 18" tall in a 5-gallon pot but would be fine in an even smaller container. S z3-10
 - Green Maiden Nelumbo nucifera A semi-double soft pink lotus with green undertones, will occasionally produce a lucky double flower on a single stem. Very easy to grow. MiniS z3-10
 - <u>High Cotton</u> Nelumbo nucifera Named to honor all those hard working men and women who paved the way for us today. Pure white outer wide petals make a perfect plate to hold the more narrow curled inner petals. Bright gold stamen surrounds a lime green receptacle. L z3-10
- NEW! o Impressions of West Lake Nelumbo nucifera Stunningly beautiful deep red lotus with a perfect shape that blooms all summer long. The flower is held high above the leaves, and will be one of the first lotus to bloom making it a great choice for our cool MN springs. L z3-10

 Lady Bug Nelumbo nucifera Itsy bitsy, teeny tiny, little love bug of a lotus! A bright red little powerhouse that blooms almost nonstop. Can be grown in a bowl or larger pot for larger lotus. Mini z3-10

- NEW! Ominesota Native Yellow Nelumbo lutea Warm creamy yellow flowers with deep green leaves can be seen from afar. Our native lotus is huge in height, leaf and flower size. L z2-10
- NEW! O Manjing Love 16 (Yu Hua Qing 16) Nelumbo nucifera Winner of the National Lotus Competition in China. A lovely creamy white lotus deeply marked in purple-violet on the outer petals with green tips on the inner petals. Like an artist hand-painted it. SM z3-10
 - Sing Birdie Sing Nelumbo nucifera Lovely white petals are rimmed in deep purple-pink. Can be grown in a very small pot. A MWGS favorite from 2021. Seen 2021 at Como Conservatory in their Bonsai Display. SM z3-10

 Somahai_Nelumbo nucifera Perfect classic dense flowers that stand high above the leaves. Deep pink on the first day with light pink centers retaining the deep pink tips on subsequent days. Our grower says "There aren't enough superlatives to describe this new addition to our line-up." M z3-10
 - Tender Love (Lian Ai) Nelumbo nucifera MWGS Best Red Lotus from 2021. Flowers continuously throughout the summer with single-petal deep red flowers. Highly recommended for a novice grower. S z3-10

 Tulip Lotus (Shirokunshi) Nelumbo nucifera Blooming all summer long with huge white classic single-petal flowers held high above leaves. Very elegant and pure, it signifies everything a classic lotus should be. L z3-10

 Mite Phoenix (Bai Feng Guang) Nelumbo nucifera Pure white miniature perfection. Incredible number of blossoms on a compact plant. Perfect for the table top. Can be grown in a microbowl 4-6" wide. If grown in a pot less than 8" wide, use the pot-in-pot method. Mini z3-10
- NEW! Or Yileen Garden Edible Lotus Nelumbo nucifera Even though all lotus offered are edible, for the first time, we are offering lotus meant to be eaten! Big round baseball size tubers are a bit differently shaped than most common vegetable varieties but just as delicious. Infrequent white blooms. Leaves are large and beautiful. We suggest growing this in a dug-in-ground plastic kiddle pool to allow tubers to spread. XL z3-10

- 9 Arrow Arum Peltandra virginica Dense clump of arrowhead leaves, with reddish stems and calla lily-like flowers. 18-24" z3-9 3" pot \$5
- Arrowhead, Broadleaf Sagittarius latifolia Small white flowers in spring. Grown for large arrowhead-shaped leaves. Edible tuber. 18-24" z3-9 Tuber \$5 1 Qt \$15
- NEW! Aster, Red-Stemmed Aster puniceus Very tall with an abundance of small light violet-blue flowers with yellow centers in autumn past the first frost.

 Attractive to butterflies. Native habitat of spring-fed meadows. 4-8' z2-9 4" pot \$4
 - Blazing Star, Marsh Liatris spicata Erect spike of rose-purple flower heads bloom from the top down in a feathery display. Grass-like leaves are clumped toward the base of the plant, but extend up the stem to the showy flower cluster. 3-4' z3-8 4" pot \$4
 - <u>Bog Bean Menyanthes trifoliata</u> Three-lobed leaves grow from rhizomes along water's surface. Trailing roots good for fish spawn. Surface trailing. z2-8 Bare Root \$3
- Bulrush, Soft-Stemmed Schoenoplectus tabernaemontani Graceful blue-green cylindrical foliage. Less aggressive than cattails. 2-6' z2-8 6" pot \$7

 Calla Lily, Native Calla pallustris Plant along slow-moving stream banks, in bogs, or in a floating island. Thick waxy leaves with a bright white calla flower in late spring 6-12" z2-6 Bare Root \$4
 - °Cardinal Flower, Red Lobelia cardinalis Bright red tubular flowers. Jul Sep 2-4' z3-9 4" pot \$4 1 Qt pot \$15
 - Coneflower, Cutleaf Rudbeckia laciniata Tall branching stems with serrated lobed leaves and yellow flowers. Blooms Jul to Oct. 5-7' z3-8 4" pot \$4 6" pot \$7
 - Cup Plant Silphium perfoliatum Huge showy plant with sunflower yellow flowers tolerant of clay and likes wet feet. Leaves surround distinctive square stem forming "cup". 4-8' z3-9 6" pot \$5 1 gallon pot \$8
 - Fireweed Epilobium angustifolium Edible narrow-leaved tall showy wildflower that thrives in open meadows, along streams, roadsides, and forest edges forming large waves of purple blossoms June Sept. 2-5' z2-7 4" pot \$4

- Ironweed, Common Veronica fasciculata Intense purple blooms stand out in the late summer landscape, attracting many butterflies and other pollinators. Tolerates moist soil with brief flooding making it great for the raingarden. Plant height may be reduced easily by cutting back the stems in late spring, giving a better show of flowers. Self seeds. 2-4' z3-9 4" pot \$4
- <u>Jewelweed</u> Impatiens capensis Annual impatiens for wet feet. Speckled orange blossoms. Self seeds. 3-4' 4" pot \$4
- Joe Pye Weed, Sweet Eupatorium purpureum Clusters of bright pink flowers in late summer. Perfect for any damp area, drainage ditch, edge of pond or raingarden. 4-6' z2-7 4" pot \$4
- Lobelia, Great Blue Lobelia siphilitica Blue tubular flowers. Jul-Sep 24-36" z3-9 4" pot \$4 1 Qt pot \$15
- Mallow, Rose Hibiscus laevis Our only native hibiscus! Large, 5-petaled, hollyhock-like flowers (to 6" diameter) with white to pink petals and maroon eyes appear from mid-summer into fall on smooth stout stems. Late to leaf out in spring, so be patient. Grows well in garden soil, but can tolerate periods below water. 4-6' z2-8 4" pot \$4
- Mare's Tail Hippuris vulgaris Soft bottle-brush looking stems rise above shallow water. Native version of parrot feather. 6-12" z2-6 1 Qt pot \$15
- eee Marsh Marigold Caltha palustris First to bloom in spring. Bog charmer with cup-shaped yellow flowers. 6-12" z2-8 4" pot \$4 1 Qt pot \$15
- Milkweed, Sullivant's Asclepias sullivantii Also known as Smooth or Prairie Milkweed. More uniform pink flower color and less aggressive than common milkweed, handling slightly more damp soil. Excellent hummingbird/butterfly attractor. 24-36" z3-7 4" pot \$4
- Milkweed, Swamp_Asclepias incarnata Easily grown in poor to average moist to wet soil. This native narrow-leaved bloomer is particularly attractive to monarchs for both nectar and larva. 3-5' z3-6 4" pot \$4
- Monkey Flower, Lavender Mimulus ringens Snapdragon-like lavender flowers. For pond edge or rain garden. 3-4' z2-8 4" pot \$4 6" pot \$7
- Rush, Common Juncus effusus A true rush with smooth, upright, cylindrical, unjointed, spire-like green stems (not leaves) which grow in spreading basal clumps. Submerge up to 4". 24-36" z4-9 4" pot \$4
 - Rush, Pickerel Blue Pontederia cordata Long, glossy heart-shaped leaves with bluish purple spikes of flowers. 24-36" z3-9 3" pot \$5 1 Qt pot \$15
- co Sedge, Lake Carex lacustris Large clumping lakeshore sedge for accent or wildlife. Attracts waterfowl. 3-4' z2-7 3" pot \$5
- Sedge, Tussock Carex stricta Clump-forming sedge with fountain-like foliage similar to prairie dropseed, but tolerates a bit of shade and periods of flooding. Great for the rain garden or edge of the pond. Nice tan fall color too. 16-24" z3-9 3" pot \$5
- NEW! See Smooth Petunia Ruellia strepens 2" lilac-lavender petunia like flowers last a day, but plant blooms from May to Sep. Care-free, will self-seed. Prefers rich open woods and borders of streams and ponds. 18-30" z4-8 4" pot \$4
- NEW! Spatterdock Nuphar advent Large heart-shaped lily-like leaves float on the water's surface or stand slightly above, with flowers held above water like tennis balls on a stick: strong yellow petals formed into a tight cup. Grow under 1-3' of water. 3' spread z3-7 Tuber \$30
 - Sweet Flag Acorus americanus Strong sword-like leaves stand green and tall all season long. Fragrant tubers give the plant its name. 24-36" z3-6 4" pot \$4
 - Vervain, Blue Verbena hastata Moisture-loving plant typically found in moist meadows and along streams. The deep blue-violet flower spikes are a highlight of the midsummer meadow, and remain blooming for up to 2 months. Individual plants are biennial, but may colonize slowly by rhizomes from the fibrous root system. Standing water is not tolerated but okay for short periods like a rain garden. 2-5' z3-8 4" pot \$4
- NEW! OBJECT: Water Smartweed Persicaria amphibia Versatile plant with both terrestrial and aquatic forms. Tightly packed racemes of pink/red/white flowers flourish June to Sep.  Mibiscus, Red Night Hibiscus acetosella Finely lobed leaves in beautiful shades of maroon and red that looks like the perfect Japanese Maple, but tolerates urban pollution and standing water. Pink hibiscus flowers are somewhat shy, but open at night. Fertilize heavily and prune early for more blooms. 3-4' z7-11 4" pot \$7
 - Milkweed, Mexican Asclepias curassavica Spectacularly bright orange-red flowers 2-4" stand out against the dark green foliage. It blooms non-stop from spring until fall and attracts pollinators. 24-36" z9-11 2" pot \$5
 - Mosaic Plant Ludwigia sedioides Floating rosettes in unique diamond geometric pattern and small yellow flowers. A conversation starter. Surface trailing. z9-11 Bare Root \$4
- NEW! OPApyrus, Compact Giant Cyperus papyrus, Compact Giant Smaller version of 'King Tut', classic Egyptian Papyrus with strong triangular stems and a huge fluffy puff of greenish flower spikelet at the top. 3-5' z10-12 1 Qt pot \$12 2.5 gal pot \$30
 - Papyrus, Dwarf Cyperus haspan Shortest of the cyperus with fuller leaf pom on top. 12-18" z7-11 2" pot \$5 1 Qt pot \$12

 - Parrot Feather Myriophyllum aquaticum Feathery foliage on edge of pond, in streams or containers. Softens rock edges. Trailing. z6-10 4" pot \$7 1 Qt pot \$15
 - <u>Parrot Feather, Dwarf Red-Stemmed</u> Myriophyllum spp Miniature version of Parrot feather with red stems. Striking in small containers. Trailing. z6-10 Bare Root \$5
- NEW! Radican, Marble Queen Echinodorus cordifolius 'Marble Queen' Amphibious plant that grows completely underwater, or above. Above is a show: sword plant leaves with very pronounced speckled creamy white variegation. White flowers on long arching stalks. 18-24" z9-11 2" pot \$5
 - Sedge, Stargrass Rhynchospora colorata Showy addition to a bog or water garden. It will also grow in regular garden soil with plenty of water. 12-15" z7-10 2" pot \$5

- All hardy waterlilies are BARE ROOT and sell from \$5-\$40 depending upon number of growing eyes, size and variety. Some have been started in a greenhouse, others are member's divisions.
- Arc-en-ciel Nymphaea Best pads on a hardy: olive green speckled with cream, pink and yellow. Large very spiky flowers held above water soft pink fades to blush. SM z3-10
- Attraction Nymphaea Red with white tint on outer petals. Very easy to grow. Great bloomer even in less sun. S z3-10
- Bernice Ikins Nymphaea Kirk Strawn hybrid has eye-catching reddish pink flower complimented by reddish green leaves. M z3-10
 Betsy Sakata Nymphaea Light-yellow petals with a faint pink on the outer petals. Dark green pads have purplish flecks. M z3-9
- Black Princess Nymphaea Such a deep red, that it almost appears black. A good bloomer with 5-6" blossoms. May fade in really hot sun and heat of the day. M 23-10
- Burgundy Princess Nymphaea The outer petals are blushed red deepening to an intense red at the inner petals. The cuplike flower measures 2-4 inches and floats amongst 4-5 inch, medium green, round leaves. S z3-10
- Chromatella Nymphaea Primrose yellow blossoms. Maroon and green pads. Great bloomer even in less sun. S z3-10
- Chrysantha Nymphaea Petite cup-shaped changeable. Peach to blush flowers with mottled pads. S z3-9
- Chubby Nymphaea Blush to pale-pink 4" flowers with classic shape. M z3-9
- Colorado Nymphaea Salmon-pink. Green pads with purple mottling. Fantastic bloomer in full sun. L z3-10
- Denver Nymphaea Multiple petals of light yellow. Large green pads dappled with purple. ML z3-10
- <u>Fuchsia Pom Pom</u> Nymphaea Best New Waterlily 2013. Vivid fuchsia pink multi-petaled blossoms on heavy bloomer. M z3-10
- Georgia Peach Nymphaea Orange/pink blossoms stay open late into the day. Mottled pads, cooler water. ML z3-10
- Gonnere Nymphaea Large pure white double flowers have a "snowball" appearance. This hardy white water lily is free flowering and pleasantly fragrant.

- Indiana Nymphaea Unique changeable each day different color starting light pink to red wine. Shy bloomer. S z3-10
- James Brydon Nymphaea An oldie but goody. This beautiful red hardy water lily has 4" to 6" peony-shaped blossoms that have a sweet apple scent. Lily pads are green. One of the few red hardy water lilies that will tolerate partial shade and still bloom. M z3-10
- Joey Tomocik Nymphaea Strongest yellow for Minnesota. Prolific bloomer stays open late in the day. Green and purple pads. ML z3-10
- <u>Layderkeri Fulgens</u> Nymphaea Crimson flowers, green pads. Good for shallow and mid-sized ponds. M z3-10
- Layderkeri Lilacea Nymphaea Dwarf pink water lily, great for container gardens. Keep shallow and well fertilized for strong blooming. Mini z3-10
- Mayla Nymphaea Brilliant fuchsia blossoms with high petal count. Needs large container and respite from full sun. L z3-10

- Painted Lady Nymphaea Free flowering really unique light pink flowers fading to white. On occasion the pink flowers have splashes of white in them, and sometimes white on half and splashy pink on the other half. Green pads are also different, speckled with white and pink. M z3-10
- Perry's Fire Opal_Nymphaea Reliable large blossoms of deep pink with multiple petals on a smaller lily makes this an eye-catcher. SM z3-10

- Perry's Double White Nymphaea Large white double, star-shaped flowers that stand above the waters' surface are slightly scented. Very prolific bloomer with green lily pads. A good selection for any size pond. M
- ^o Pink Grapefruit Nymphaea Pink to salmon blossoms, holds color well. Green pads with some purple flecks. M z3-10
- Red Spider Nymphaea Free-flowering spiky-red petals like a spider. Green pads with purple speckles. SM z3-10
- Sioux (Orange Changeable) Nymphaea Flowers open yellow, changing to deep orange and finally copper red on the third day. Early to start blooming in the spring, but a bit shy. S z3-10
- Sunfire Nymphaea Large pink blossoms with brilliant salmon/yellow centers. Prolific bloomer even in part shade. ML z3-10
- <u>Tetragona</u> *Nymphaea* Smallest of the small, considered pygmy. Pure white adorable flowers great for containers & small ponds. Mini z3-10
- Texas Dawn Nymphaea Reliable yellow hardy. Will hold blooms above water. Give this one space and stand back. L z3-10
- Virginia Nymphaea Free-flowering large snow white flowers that surround a radiant yellow center stand slightly above the water. Green leaves with noticeable purple blotches on young leaves. L z3-9
- <u>Wanvisa Nymphaea</u> 2010 Waterlily of the year. Very unusual variable colors make each bloom from same plant a surprise. Pink, yellow, and salmon speckled and solid in each bloom. Gorgeous mottled pads. M z3-10
