CARNIVOROUS PLANTS

All Sarracenia spp. are 5 yr old blooming plants which need winter dormancy. These are greenhouse started with actively growing traps. Growing tips included with purchase.

- Pitcher Plant, Northern Purple Sarracenia purpurea purpurea Native MN pitcher. Deep reddish-purple very stout waxy pitchers, holds color through winter. Dark red fragrant flowers. 4-8" z2-8 3.5" pot \$25
- <u>Pitcher Plant, Maroon</u> Sarracenia x maroon (s. purpurea x rubra [s. x chelsonii]) Dark maroon traps all season including winter. Fragrant dark red flowers bloom early spring. 6-8" z5-9 3.5" pot \$25
