All *Sarracenia* spp. are 5 yr old blooming plants which need winter dormancy. These are greenhouse started with actively growing traps. Growing tips included with purchase.

- NEW!** ☼ **Big Bug Combo** *various* A great collection of carnivorous plants (more than just pitcher plants) which will live happily inside the home in a sunny window on a shallow tray of distilled water. **5" pot \$25**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Love Bug** *S. psittacina x purpurea x minor x [S. purpurea x S. jonesii]* Many compact deep red narrow pitchers with broad wide red ruffled hood. Fragrant red flowers bloom mid-season. 8-10" Z5-9 **4" pot \$25.00**
- ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Northern Purple** *Sarracenia purpurea purpurea* Native MN pitcher. Deep reddish-purple very stout waxy pitchers, holds color through winter. Dark red fragrant flowers. 4-8" z2-8 **4" pot \$25**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Parrot** *S psittacina* Prostrate pitchers have a rosette appearance with some variable red at the tip. Small red flowers 6-8" z5-9 **4" pot \$25**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Red Bug** *S. rubra spp. wherryi x S. rubra spp. rubra* Deep red veining with wide and wavy scalloped hood holds the deep red color all winter long. More sun, means more red. Vigorous. 6-8" z5-9 **4" pot \$25**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Southern** *Sarracenia purpurea x venosa* A subspecies of the Northern Purple. Venosa, meaning "distinctly veined", it follows the northern pitcher in form, but coloration of dark red veins abound on the upper traps. 4-8" z4-9 **4" pot \$25**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pitcher Plant, White Trumpet 'Judith Hindle'** *Sarracenia leucophylla 'Judith Hindle'* Marbled ruffled hoods start green laced with yellow then darken to deep red maroon with white, yellow and green mottling. Very showy in fall when other pitchers fade. Moderately fragrant maroon red flowers in early spring before tubes fully develop. 8-14" z6-10 **4" pot \$25**
- ☼ **Pitcher Plant, Yellow Trumpet** *Sarracenia flava* Large chartreuse green pitchers with occasional red veining. Showy yellow very fragrant flowers bloom early before traps. 12-32" z6-10 **4" pot \$25**

- NEW!** ☼☼ **Frogbit, American** *Limnobium spongia* Small thick spongy leaves that float on surface or roots in very shallow water. Frog favorite and great duck food. 2-4" z5-10 **Bare Root(4) \$6**
- NEW!** ☼☼ **Red Root Floater** *Phyllanthus fluitans* A floating fern to cover water in containers with added benefit of red roots and red foliage given enough sun. 1" z8-10 **Bare Root (1/4 cup) \$6**
- ☼☼ **Water Hyacinth** *Eichhornia crassipes* Floating plant great for filtration & containers. Glossy bulbed leaves and showy lavender flower. 6-12" z9-11 **Bare Root \$6**

- ☼☼ **Angelica, Korean** *Angelica gigas* Striking plant for moist woodland or bog. Blooms burgundy in fall through hard freeze. Most asked-about plant at the State Fair pond. 3-5' z4-9 **4" pot \$4 6" pot \$7**
- NEW!** ☼ **Arrowhead 'Crushed Ice'** *Sagittaria gramineus* 'Crushed Ice' Mottled creamy variegation in all sorts of patterns pepper the elongated upright leaves. Spring spray of small white flowers enhance the show. 18-24" z3-8 **4" pot \$8**
- NEW!** ☼ **Arrowhead, Double** *Sagittaria japonica 'plena'* Large double-petaled flowers in the spring. Arrowhead lance shaped leaves with bright white pom-pom flowers on a raceme. 24-36" z4-9 **4" pot \$8**
- ☼☼ **Bloody Dock** *Rumex sanguineus* An edible herb (sorrel) with gorgeous dark red veins on deep green upright foliage that likes wet feet. 12-15" z4-8 **4" pot \$8**
- ☼☼ **Brooklime, European** *Veronica beccabunga* Spectacular creeper over the sides of containers, in streams, along the pond edge. Forms a mat of vegetation near pond edge that attracts frogs and other wildlife. - ☼☼ **Butterbur** *Petasites hybridus* Huge leaves. Likes moist woodlands or bogs. Deer and rabbit resistant. 3-4' z4-7 **1 gal pot \$7**

- ☼☼ **Cattail, Miniature** *Typha minima* The true "miniature". Perfectly dainty in a container. Catkins about 1" round. 12-15" z4-9 **4" pot \$8 1 Qt pot \$18**
- ☼☼ **Chameleon Plant** *Houttuynia cordata* Tricolor variegated heart-shaped leaves on vining plant with underground rhizomes. 8-12" z3-9 **4" pot \$8**
- ☼☼ **Globeflower, Golden Queen** *Trollius chinensis 'Golden Queen'* Large, creamy orange double flowers on strong upright stems and a nice compact habit. Really stands out in full shade given enough moisture. Great for raingardens. 18-24" z4-9 **4" pot \$5**
- ☼ **Golden Club** *Orontium aquaticum* A true aquatic with pointed oval leaves repel water like a lotus. Long golden spadex add unique interest in late spring. 12-24" z5 **2" pot \$5**

IRIS PSEUDATA

New Hybrid sterile cross between *Iris pseudocaris* and *Iris ensata* giving better vigor from Japanese Iris, and colors not normally found without the invasiveness of *pseudocaris*.

- NEW! ☼ **Iris Cascadian Snow** *Iris pseudata 'Cascadian Snow'* Large creamy-white blooms have a yellow signal with faint yellow veins and violet eyelashes. Foliage starts chartreuse in the spring transitioning to green as it matures. 4-5' z5-9 **Bare Root \$9**
- NEW! ☼ **Iris Chaki** *Iris pseudata 'Chaki'* Peachy-rose blooms have a yellow eye, with wine-colored eyelashes and darker red styles. Early bloomer. 30-38" z5-9 **Bare Root \$9**

- NEW! ☼☼ **Moneywort, Persian Chocolate** *Lysimachia congestiflora* Great groundcover with purple-chocolate rounded leaves and bright yellow flowers starting in early summer. Needs the moist soil on the edge of a pond. 2-3' z6-9 **Bare Root \$5**
- NEW! ☼☼ **Rhubarb, Indian** *Darmera peltiphyllum* Large green lobed and prickly leaves like an inside-out umbrella emerge from a rhizome after a large flower stalk in early spring. Creates a large mound in shady boggy constantly wet soil, or raingarden. 3-5' z5-7 **Bare Root \$6**
- NEW! ☼ **Rice, Black Madras** *Orya Sativa* Deciduous biannual grass with upright to arching, broadly linear, dark purple leaves forming open panicles of bright green flower spikelets in the fall. 12-18" z2-11 **Bare Root \$6**
- NEW! ☼ **Rush, Pickerel White** *Pontederia cordata alba* Tall glossy elongated leaves start late, but put on a beautiful all-summer show. Pannicle of white bottlebrush flowers mid to late summer. 24-36" z3-10 **1 Qt pot \$18**
- ☼☼ **Rush, Spiral Blue Medusa** *Juncus effusus 'Blue Medusa'* Fun curly tuft of blue/green spirals on a compact plant. 12-15" z4-9 **4" pot \$8**
- ☼☼ **Sedge, Bowles Golden** *Carex elata 'Bowles Golden'* Bright gold tufted foliage with thin green margins. Moisture loving grass that needs to be constantly wet or moist to thrive. 24-30" z4-8 **Bare Root \$7**
- Sweet Flag, Dwarf Ogon** *Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'* Darling miniature iris-like striped yellow and green foliage. 8-12" z5-10 **4" pot \$5**
- ☼ **Sweet Flag, Varigated** *Acorus calamus variegata* Iris-like foliage with unusual vertical variegation. Maintenance-free. 24-36" z3-10 **Bare Root \$3-\$10**
- NEW! ☼☼ **Thalia, Powdery** *Thalia dealbata* Dramatic clump of long paddle-shaped blue-green foliage atop strong upright stems. Packed panicles of purple flowers sits at the end of a long arching stem. Pollinator attractor. 3-6' z6-11 **2" pot \$5**
- ☼☼ **Water Baby's Breath, European** *Alisma plantago aquatica* Hosta-looking plant for the water that provides a flourish of blush to white tiny flowers like a cloud on a tall spike. 24-36" z3-9 **Bare Root \$5**
- NEW! ☼☼ **Water Baby's Breath, Spoonleaf** *Alisma parviflorum 'Spoon Leaf'* More broad leaves and slightly shorter than European or Native varieties. Numerous flower heads with multiple delicate pinkish-white petals 20-30" z3-9 **Bare Root \$5**
- NEW! ☼☼ **Water Clover, Variegated** *Marsilea mutica var.* Concentric circles of varying shades of green and brown on each petal. Leaves float on surface unless planted very shallow where they will slightly rise. Surface to 6" z5-11 **Bare Root \$5**
- ☼ **Water Forget-Me-Not** *Myosotis scorpioides* Periwinkle blue flowers on plant that thrives in water and wet feet. 6-8" z4-8 **4" pot \$5**

- ☼ **Yerba Mansa** *Anemopsis californica* Herb native from Oregon to Southern California. Sturdy thick oblong green leaves which turn beautiful shades of gold, orange and red in the fall. The flower is a spray of bright white petals surrounding a long cone-like stigma. 12-24" z5-10 **Bare Root \$6 1 Qt pot \$18**

LOTUS

All lotus are bare root tubers. Prices range from \$5-\$50 depending upon variety and size of tuber. Multiple price points are available in each variety. All lotus need full sun and are hardy in zones 3-10 if stored deep in water, but tubers must not freeze. Check website for recommended pot size.

- ☼ **Ai Jiangnan** *Nelumbo nucifera* Plate-like huge cheery yellow flowers with green tips on first day, adding some creamy pink on subsequent days. Flowers held above the very low and wide deep blue-green leaves. **M**
- NEW! ☼ **Autumn in Molding** *Nelumbo nucifera* Bright true yellow flowers drape dramatically as it opens to reveal a multitude of petals, putting on a show all summer long after a slow start. **M/L**
- NEW! ☼ **Beautiful Dancer** *Nelumbo nucifera* One of the first lotus to bloom. A versicolor lotus with different colors each day of the bloom. Opening day is a vivid pink changing to light creamy yellow with pink outer edges as it matures. Classic lotus shape with LOTS of flowers. Very dependable bloomer. **S**
- NEW! ☼ **Chinese Red (Jing gang shan)** *Nelumbo nucifera* Brilliant red color highlights this heavy bloomer. Outer petals are elongated and drape beautifully around the full inner petals beautifully as it ages while staying a nice red throughout. **L**
- NEW! ☼ **Crab Claws (Ziezhaua Hong)** *Nelumbo nucifera* A great lotus in every way: Uniformly shaped plant, multiple flowers throughout the summer, beautiful multi-petaled red flowers with lighter inner petals and a bright interior yellow. Unique red seed pods are an added bonus for color and floral arrangements. A heavy bloomer. **Mini/S**
- ☼ **Dancing in Jade Tower** *Nelumbo nucifera* Best MN bloomer in 2021. Grows to size of container, perfect for small pots on patio. Single and semi-double on same plant changes pink to white with pink edges. **S**

- NEW!** ☼ **Decorated Lantern** *Nelumbo nucifera* A very dependable bloomer, the first day flower is pink and the color changes each day. The center becomes a warm creamy white, while the outer tips remain dark pink. **M**
- ☼ **Dunhuang Red (Dunhuang Hong)** *Nelumbo nucifera* Luscious pink flowers bigger than a dinner plate and broad petals. Flower ages to a soft pink that almost glows. Plant in large tub only to support weight of flowers. Great bloomer once it gets going. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Evening Showers** *Nelumbo nucifera* First day flower is luminous pink maturing to yellow petals tipped in pink. Golden stamen with fat white tips curl elegantly around the receptacle. A very heavy bloomer with flowers all summer. **M**
- NEW!** ☼ **False Moonlight** *Nelumbo nucifera* A rainbow of different shades on the same flower, from vibrant pink to a glowing gold. Early spring flowers have petaloids which often have a lovely crown, but when the weather warms up, the flowers produce a regular seed pod. **M**
- NEW!** ☼ **Flame Clouds** *Nelumbo nucifera* Extremely dependable soft red single flowers which hold their shape and color as the flower matures. Ruffled golden stamens are especially beautiful. **S**
- NEW!** ☼ **Glowing Queen** *Nelumbo nucifera* Highly recommended by our grower, this very small lotus stays loaded with big full delicate pink flowers having a lovely, uniform shape. **Mini/S**
- NEW!** ☼ **Golden Horse in Jade Palace** *Nelumbo nucifera* Multiple blooms all summer long. White multi-petaled flower has bright green receptacle. Newly opened bud has a greenish tint to the petals. Compact, well-shaped plant with deep green leaves. **M**
- ☼ **Green Maiden** *Nelumbo nucifera* A semi-double soft pink lotus with green undertones, will occasionally produce a lucky double flower on a single stem. Very easy to grow. **Mini/S**
- ☼ **High Cotton** *Nelumbo nucifera* Pure white outer wide petals make a perfect plate to hold the more narrow curled inner petals. Bright gold stamen surrounds a lime green receptacle. Favorite large white of MWGS. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Ju Zi** *Nelumbo nucifera* Tall and regal with numerous flowers and lovely seed pods on a classic dark pink single petaled lotus. Retains its beautiful pink color without fading. Incredible tuber production for those who like to keep lotus from year to year or share with others. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Lady Bingley** *Nelumbo nucifera* Early prolific bloomer making it perfect for MN. There are often flowers before there are aerial leaves present. The rich, red color is delightful and it often boasts multiple flowers and buds at the same time. **S**
- ☼ **Lady Bug** *Nelumbo nucifera* Itsy bitsy, teeny tiny, little love bug of a lotus! A bright red little powerhouse that blooms almost nonstop. Can be grown in a bowl or larger pot for larger lotus. **Mini**
- ☼ **Maggie Belle Slocum** *Nelumbo nucifera* Classic pointed lotus flowers of deep fuschia. Large and free-flowering. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Mini Blood** *Nelumbo nucifera* One of the darkest deep red flowers found on an Exquisite of Bowl lotus. Perfectly shaped multi-petal flowers with red coin coloration on new leaves. **Mini**
- ☼ **Mrs. Perry D. Slocum** *Nelumbo nucifera* Queen of all lotus, this reliable multipetal versicolor bloomer starts pink turning to cream over three days. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Nanjing Love 16 (Yu Hua Qing 16)** *Nelumbo nucifera* Winner of the National Lotus Competition in China. A lovely creamy white lotus deeply marked in purple-violet on the outer petals with green tips on the inner petals. Like an artist hand-painted it. **S/M**
- NEW!** ☼ **Oriole Out of Water** *Nelumbo nucifera* A green oval-shaped bud opens into a cheerful creamy-yellow flower with pink tinges. This lotus blooms early and continues late into the summer long after other lotus have finished. Very dependable. **S/M**
- NEW!** ☼ **Perry's Giant Sunburst** *Nelumbo nucifera* A king of the lotus, there's a reason it's been around for years. Constant HUGE flowers on this big sunny yellow ray of sunshine are held high above the leaves and sway in the breeze. Really spectacular, but needs room. **L**
- NEW!** ☼ **Pure Girl** *Nelumbo nucifera* One of the smallest lotus we have offered. Pure white flowers occasionally have green tips on the inner petals as it opens. Dark green leaves are only a few inches in diameter. **Mini**
- NEW!** ☼ **Scarlet Lady** *Nelumbo nucifera* A perfectly balanced plant with deep red single to double blooms and dark green leaves, which draws one's attention. **S**
- ☼ **Sing Birdie Sing** *Nelumbo nucifera* Lovely white petals are rimmed in deep purple-pink. Can be grown in a very small pot. A MWGS favorite from 2021. **S/M**
- NEW!** ☼ **Sparks** *Nelumbo nucifera* Delicate classically shaped single flowers are held high above the leaves showing off its beauty. Bud and 1st day flower are a lovely deep red fading to a solid pink on subsequent days. **S**
- NEW!** ☼ **Sunrise Brocade** *Nelumbo nucifera* An incredibly unique and gorgeous coloration on a single-petaled flower. The brightly colored flower is solid yellow with red edges and emerald green in the middle occasionally producing a brocade ruffle on the petals. And it is a great bloomer to boot! **M**

- ◉ **Tender Love (Lian Ai)** *Nelumbo nucifera* MWGS Best Red Lotus from 2021. Flowers continuously throughout the summer with single-petal deep red flowers. Highly recommended for a novice grower. **S**
- NEW!** ◉ **White Crane** *Nelumbo nucifera* So elegant! Classic pure white single petals surround golden stamen with a yellow-green receptacle, which emphasizes the purity of the white petals. **Mini/S**

- NEW!** ◉◉ **Arrow Arum** *Peltandra virginica* Dense clump of arrowhead leaves, with reddish stems and calla lily-like flowers. 18-24" z3-9 **Bare Root \$3 2" pot \$5**
- NEW!** ◉◉ **Arrowhead, Broadleaf** *Sagittarius latifolia* Small white flowers in spring. Grown for large arrowhead-shaped leaves. Edible tuber. 18-24" z3-9 **Tubers \$5 4" pot \$8 1 Qt pot \$18**
- NEW!** ◉◉◉ **Blazing Star, Meadow** *Liatris ligulistylis* Erect spike of rose-purple flowerheads with grass-like leaves extending up the stem. 3-4' z3-8 **3" pot \$5**
